REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

Application for Admission

The application for admission should be completed in its entirety to the best of your ability.

Personal Statement

The personal statement is an opportunity for you to introduce yourself to the Admissions Committee. You may discuss, among other topics, personal or professional goals, or your personal, academic, or career history.

Resume or Curriculum Vitae

The resume you include in your Northwestern Pritzker Law application should include professional, education, and leadership experiences you feel are relevant to your candidacy.

The Law School LLM Credential Assembly Service

The Law School Credential Assembly Service (CAS) report contains a summary of each applicant's:

- Post-Secondary Transcript(s) translated into English,
- TOEFL or IELTS Score Report (for international applicants),
- At least one Letter of Recommendation or Evaluation.

Application Fee

A nonrefundable application fee of \$75 is required to submit your application.

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION MATERIALS

Evaluative Interview (invitation only)

Admissions interviews for the LLM in Taxation program are by invitation only after an application has been submitted and reviewed by the Admissions Committee. Interviews provide the Admissions Committee with additional information about your communication skills, maturity, and motivation.
